With the new developments, there is more water than the 30 inch pipe can let out of the 4x6 box culvert. The Mayor and ODOT have talked about putting in a larger pipe and other measures to stop the flooding, but the problem will reoccur on Bacon Road as that pipe is also only 30 inches. So the same problem will exist, just at a different location. The Mayor will keep the Board apprised. Commissioner Ohler advised it has to be fixed. Commissioner Wirkner asked if Brace's property is getting a lot of flooding. The Mayor advised the water is coming up near the door and the trailer rental business across the street has been flooded from it. Commissioner Wirkner agreed it makes sense to coordinate efforts.

Ed Eick, Maintenance Supervisor, appeared before the Board to discuss the exterior cleaning of the west side of the Courthouse from the pigeons. Mr. Eick has received two quotes, but they are not "apples to apples". Coon Restoration's quote was \$16,148.00, and First Choice Pest Management came in at \$31,670.00. Mr. Eick advised that Coon Restoration has the most experience and with the quote they gave us they will clean the west side of the building from roof to ground level. The pigeon droppings on the balcony would be an additional cost of approximately \$2,000.00. First Choice Pest Management does not have the equipment so they would have to rent most of it, and they require a down payment of \$20,500.00. Their quote includes installation of a netting to keep the pigeons from building nests and an ultrasonic sound. Mr. Eick advised he has spoken with other counties and they have not found anything to keep the pigeons controlled. He has seen pigeon spikes, but he doesn't think that will work since we have the bell tower.

Ed Eick, Maintenance Supervisor, appeared before the Board to discuss the Child Support Enforcement Agency (CSEA) flooding. Mr. Eick does not think there is anything the Village can do because it isn't from the street. Mr. Eick advised the County has a situation with the sidewalk, drainage, and retaining wall by the entrance door. There is runoff coming down the asphalt drive and runoff coming out of the downspouts from the rooftop. There is a system inside the basement, which is drainage with a sump that also pumps out in that area. The drains in the sidewalk have a 4 inch drain, so if something blocks it, there is flooding. Mr. Eick recommended having the drainage brought out from the doorway and have a retaining wall come further out from the entrance where that water will curve and go further out. He also suggested tearing up the sidewalk and replacing the drain there. If you look at it from the street, you can see the elevation of the sidewalk is actually leaning to the building. It is not only in that area, but it is creating water inside the basement. Commissioner Ohler asked what the first process would be. Mr. Eick advised it is going to turn into a large project, as the whole area is nothing but sandstone and installation of a footer and rebar will probably be necessary. He believes drawings will be needed for this project. Commissioner Ohler advised this is still a work in progress.

The time having arrived to hold a public hearing regarding the Carroll County Budget for 2016, the following persons were present: Thomas R. White, Jeffrey L. Ohler, Robert E. Wirkner, Stacy Taylor, Lynn Fairclough, Nancy Schaar, Janice Leggett, and Valerie Mossor. Auditor Fairclough advised Ms. Taylor has prepared the figures very conservatively. Ms. Taylor advised the “permissive taxes” include the casino revenue, sales tax and conveyance fees, and these fluctuate. Commissioner Ohler asked if the actual receipts for 2014 totaled about \$8,643,000, and the conservative estimate for 2016 is \$7,357,000. Ms. Taylor advised yes, but the \$7 million figure is just total receipts, not carryover. The estimated carryover for 2016 will be about \$1.9 million. Commissioner Ohler clarified that the budget requests by county departments total \$8.9 million; therefore, with \$7.3 million in estimated receipts, a minimum of \$1.6 million in carryover will be necessary. Ms. Taylor advised yes, but the budget requests have not increased much because 2015 requests were approximately \$8.867 million. Commissioner Wirkner asked when the Auditor’s office expects to reach anticipated income. Ms. Taylor estimated possibly September. Commissioner Ohler advised it seems the budget matches or exceeds receipts on a yearly basis, and he is uncomfortable using that same method going forward. Ms. Taylor advised the budget figures are conservative, and receipts like casino revenue, oil and gas royalties and bonuses are not in the estimates.
