

**CARROLL COUNTY BIDDING NOTICE
PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENT - CDBG FY16**

**Village of Carrollton, Ohio – Alley Paving
Village of Dellroy, Ohio – McCarty Lane**

The Board of Commissioners of Carroll County will accept bids up to and open them at 9:45am on July, 24, 2017 in their office in the Courthouse at Carrollton for the resurfacing of the existing pavement on the below listed roads.

Carrollton Alley (Located between 4th & 5th Sts., NE in Carrollton) is 370 feet long and 10 feet wide. There will be surface preparation, 75 square yards of pavement repair, 50 gallons of tack coat, 25 CY (1.5") of 441 Asphalt Concrete Surface Course, Type 1 (448).

McCarty Lane (Located in Dellroy) is 925 feet long and 10 feet wide. There will be surface preparation, 50 square yards of pavement repair, 125 gallons of tack coat, 32 CY (1") of 441 Asphalt Concrete Intermediate Course, Type 1 (448) and 32 CY (1") of 441 Asphalt Concrete Surface Course, Type 1 (448).

"Bids in excess of \$30,000.00 shall be accompanied by a certified check made payable to the Board of Commissioners in the amount of not less than 10% of the bid amount, or a bond in the full amount of the bid that substantially complies with all applicable requirements of Section 153.54(B) ORC and 153.571 ORC. "Any bid submitted contrary to these requirements may be rejected by the Board of Commissioners.

The bid shall be for the cost of the labor, material, and associated expenses of items described in the plan and specifications. Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked:

PAVING - CDBG FY16

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements as determined by the Ohio Department of Development as well as Federal and State Equal Employment laws and regulations.

The Board of Commissioners reserves the right to waive any formalities, accept or reject any or all bids, and to determine the lowest and/or best bid.

Each proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experience on projects of similar size and complexity, and a complete listing of all subcontractors to be used.

A representative of the company should be present at the bid opening.
