**PROCLAMATION**  
**CARROLL COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES**  
**APPRECIATION & RECOGNITION DAY**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Carroll County finds that it is an important goal to support and recognize the service, efforts and devotion to duty of the emergency services of Carroll County, Ohio; and

**WHEREAS**, in support of the service, efforts, and devotion to duty of the emergency services, the Board seeks to recognize those individuals of Carroll County's public safety forces who perform above and beyond the call of duty in their services to saving or protecting life and property; and

**WHEREAS**, to emphasize the importance of service, efforts, and devotion to duty of Carroll County's emergency services who so perform and in appreciation of all who serve Carroll County, and the value to the community, a period should be set aside to memorialize individuals who serve this County as emergency service personnel.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CARROLL COUNTY, OHIO**, that the first Monday of each and every March hereafter be memorialized as *Carroll County Emergency Services Appreciation & Recognition Day* to emphasize the importance of and the contributions made to those who perform their duties above and beyond the call of duty in the saving or protecting of life and property in service to the citizens of Carroll County, State of Ohio.

**SECTION 1: NOMINATION OF INDUCTEES.** By March 1 each year, the chief or department head will forward a letter requesting the proposed candidate be considered for induction. The letter should state specifically why the chief or department head believes the candidate should be considered for induction. A copy of the report of the event leading to the nomination shall also be included.

The nomination documents will be stored at the Carroll County Commissioners' office until the Selection Committee meets to consider potential inductees.

**SECTION 2: SELECTION COMMITTEE.** A Selection Committee shall be formed totaling five (5) members who represent the various disciplines that comprise Carroll County emergency services. The Committee will be chaired by the Carroll County Sheriff. The Committee will review the potential inductees and make its recommendation to the Carroll County Commissioners of not more than ten individuals for induction each year. The three categories of recognition include Gallantry, Lifesaving and Commendation.

**SECTION 3: DONATIONS.** A Special Revenue Non-County General Fund has been submitted to the State Auditor for approval in order to receive donations and pay for awards and other items associated with the recognition of County emergency services.
