

## **RESOLUTION #2016-31**

### **RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADOPTION OF AN ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF APPORTIONMENT OF THE UNDIVIDED LOCAL GOVERNMENT FUND**

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 5747.53(B) authorizes adoption of an alternative method for determining the amount to be apportioned from the undivided Local Government Fund among the various political subdivisions within a county; and

**WHEREAS**, adoption of an alternative method of apportionment for the undivided Local Government Fund requires the approval of the Board of County Commissioners; the legislative authority of the city, located wholly or partially in the county, with the greatest population; and a majority of the boards of township trustees and legislative authorities of municipal corporations, located wholly or partially in the county; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of Carroll County, Ohio desires to approve the alternative method for allocation of the undivided Local Government Funds as proposed.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Commissioners of Carroll County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of its members thereto concurring as follows:

Section 1: The following alternative method of apportionment of the undivided Local Government Funds was approved previously in 1989 and has been in effect since that time:

- a. The fourteen (14) townships, combined, shall receive not less than ten (10) percent nor more than fifteen (15) percent of the total Local Government Fund allocation.
- b. The seven (7) villages, combined, shall receive not less than twenty-five (25) percent nor more than thirty (30) percent of the total Local Government Fund allocation.
- c. The County of Carroll shall receive not more than sixty (60) percent of the total Local Government Fund allocation.

Section 2: That the distribution of the undivided Local Government Funds be distributed for 2017 on the following basis:

- a. The fourteen (14) townships, combined, shall receive not less than twenty-five (25) percent of the total Local Government Fund allocation.
- b. The seven (7) villages, combined, shall receive not less than twenty-five (25) percent of the total Local Government Fund allocation.
- c. The County of Carroll shall receive not less than fifty (50) percent of the total Local Government Fund allocation.

Section 3: That a certified copy of this Resolution shall be sent to the Carroll County Budget Commission.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 5: That the Board of Commissioners of Carroll County, Ohio hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Mr. Ohler moved for the adoption of the preceding Resolution.
